You will participate in some of the experiences offered to school groups when you book, or take part online in a civics and citizenship program at these venues.

PROGRAM: Registration opens **9.00am** in the lobby of Parliament House, Spring Street (opposite Parliament Station) for a **9:30am** sharp start. The morning program includes a presentation by the members of the Civics and Citizenship Network and other organisations, a tour of Parliament House, a tour of City Museum at Old Treasury, Spring St and morning tea.

An afternoon session will take place between **2.00pm-3.15pm** and will involve visiting and experiencing one of the following programs: Electoral Education Old Melbourne Gaol – Crime and Justice Experience or PROV archive and exhibition tour.
